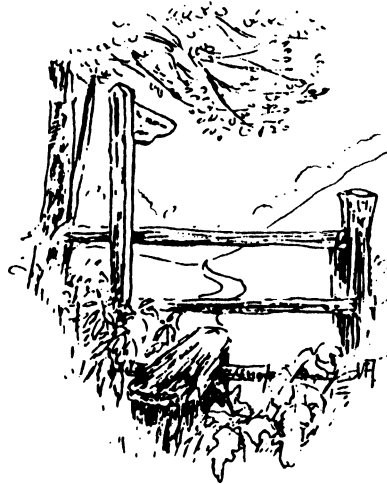

In April 1999, fellowship member John Barnes produced the first index to the Edward Thomas Fellowship Newsletters. The index covered the period 1980 to 1999 Newsletter numbers 1 to 40 inclusive.

The second phase of the index compiled by Colin G. Thornton covered the period 2000 to 2008 Newsletter numbers 41 to 60 inclusive

The headings are as the published articles wherever possible.

The first eighteen Newsletters were written by the founder and first Chairman of the Edward Thomas Fellowship, Anne Mallinson and Alan A. Martin who was the Hon. Secretary at that time.
